



Principal's Executive Group (PEG)

1. Context for Website

- 1.1. The Principal's Executive Group (PEG) is chaired by the College Principal. It is the main operationalisation body of the College and it reports to the Board of Directors. The PEG comprises senior managers (academic and non-academic) and meets monthly;
- 1.2. The main function of the PEG is to attend to the operation and management of the College in a systematic manner. The PEG addresses issues or concerns that arise and where necessary, responds quickly to the ever-changing educational environment. The PEG also has a function to encourage communication between all departments through collegiate responsibility. It communicates with all groups and reports directly to the BoD;
- 1.3. The PEG receives the actions arising from all sources and receives regular reports from the All-Staff Meeting, Student Engagement Group (SEG) and Public Information Monitoring Group (PIMG) for review and where appropriate operationalises outcomes.
